

# FSB announces appointment of new Chief Executive Officer

Contributing to society through the pursuit of education and learning, Mr Mohammed Zaidi is an exceptionally experienced strategic leader with a successful track record in key leadership roles within large Higher Education providers, in addition to having prior successful business

experience in the private sector.
