Entry Requirements

Applications based on previous qualifications:

We accept a wide range of qualifications for entry to our undergraduate programmes

- Level 3 qualification (equivalent to either 60 credits or 80 UCAS tariff points)
- A minimum of five GCSE passes at grade C/4 or above (including Maths and English).
- BTEC Extended Diploma grades Pass
- T Level – overall grade Pass (A* - C)
- International Baccalaureate overall score 32
- Access to HE Dip 60 credits (45 at Level 3 at Merit or above)
- ATHE Level 3 diploma with 60 credits
- Qualifi Level 3 diploma with 60 credits

Mature learners (Aged 21+)

If you are applying as a mature learner (aged 21+) and do not have the above qualifications, you can apply via our assessment based entry and we will consider your prior experiences (work, voluntary, life, and other experiences) that are relevant to the course.

You will be required to complete the following:

- Provide supporting documents – Valid ID, Personal Statement and proof of address dated within the last three months.
- For applicants from non-majority English speaking countries, an overall IELTS score of 5.5 is expected, with no less than 5.5 for all the individual elements.
- Complete a APEL (Accreditation of Prior Experiential Learning) essay.
- Applicants will also be invited to attend an Interview.
- Additional documents may be requested depending on the nature of your application.
