Entry Requirements

You'll normally have a good undergraduate honours degree in any academic subject. You may be considered without an undergraduate degree if you can demonstrate considerable relevant experience. You may be asked to attend an interview.

If English is not your first language, you'll need to provide evidence of proficiency in the English language. Applications for postgraduate study will require English language proficiency equivalent to an IELTS score of between 6.0 and 7.0, with a minimum of 5.5 in each component (Writing, Listening, Reading and Speaking). However all applications will be assessed individually by the Admissions Team.
